The easterly redwood tree on the island at the corner of Old Tower Rd and McGlinchey Rd is showing severe signs of dying (brown needles) but our tree horticulturalist says that heavy watering may bring it back to life. The sprinkler duration has been increased and new green growth is coming out so the tree should recover.

Another tree on the island south of 1804 Old Tower Rd has "crown rot" (generally a fatal plant disease) but no action appears to be necessary at this time.

The Livermore Animal Control says that Grey Foxes are **not** aggressive toward humans. Coyotes are also **not** aggressive toward humans but they recommend in either case that residents keep their cats and other small animals indoors in the evening. In particular, do NOT leave animal food out where the fox or coyote could feed. Both wild animals are known to become agressive when protecting food.
