1929 - 2014

Resident of Forest Glade Estates, Livermore. David whose distinguished educational career culminated with eight years as the chancellor of the California Community College System, died Oct. 9, 2014.

After retiring, he poured himself into volunteer leadership, serving 17 years on the ValleyCare Health System Board of Directors including nine years as chairman, as well as helping found and lead the Las Positas College Foundation for 11 years. He is a past-president of the Rotary Club of Livermore and brought Rotary together with ValleyCare on several medical projects.

David spearheaded medical projects that often involved multiple Rotary clubs from a variety of countries that provided medical equipment. Among the countries that benefitted were Hungary, Nepal, Azerbaijan, Romania, Turkey and Kosovo.

David attended the University of California, Berkeley and earned a Masters of Arts in zoology in 1959 and his Doctor of Philosophy with original research in zoology in 1966.

He is survived by his wife Barbara.

James Wang - FGE Treasurer



Spray-on DNA could be new weapon against food-borne illnesses

To prevent and contain outbreaks of food-borne illness, which sicken 1 in 6 Americans annually, a Bay Area startup is developing bar codes that go directly on fruits and vegetables. But you may overlook them: they're DNA-size.

Using technology invented at Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory, DNATrek is creating liquids that each contain a unique DNA sequence. The odorless, colorless and tasteless solution peppers the surface of produce, with a genetic bar code that can be identified by a special machine.

The technology could solve the enormous challenge of tracing an outbreak's source — the places where food items are grown, packed and shipped.


