CC&Rs Revision Committee Update

Thanks again to **Jim Mackanic**, our Vice President, who has taken on spearheading the CC&Rs Revision Committee. As of now, all proposed changes have been incorporated into the draft document. The Board will review the revisions and then distribute the draft to the neighborhood for informal comment and review prior to a formal, legal review and official vote. More information to come!

Mailboxes

The Board notified the neighborhood in a separate mailing earlier this spring that they would not be able to fund a full-HOA replacement of the current mailboxes. They had received requests by homeowners who wanted locking mailboxes or larger boxes that could accommodate bigger packages and mail, but it simply wasn't financially feasible to replace all the mailboxes in the HOA. Therefore, homeowners interested in replacing their mailboxes should work with their neighbors.

Recently, the **Haugens** and the **Lau/Gibbins** replaced their mailbox setup. They chose a locking model with double mailboxes set in reinforced concrete.

In December, a dead cedar tree located at Old Tower Rd and Forest Ln was removed by a professional crew. The stump will remain so as not to disturb the other cedar tree living in that landscaping island. The Board has decided to add a tree near the tennis courts as a replacement for the tree that was removed, and based on the sun in that location, Alden Lane made a recommendation that we plant a maple tree. The Board is in the process of obtaining an alternate, second recommendation from a nursery in Gilroy. More information to come!

Treasurer's Report

Given the changes the past few years in our FGE HOA election cycle (December through November), the Board has decided to align the fiscal year with the tax year, which runs from January to December. To bridge the transition between our current July-trough-June budget schedule, the Board has proposed a 6-month budget from July to December for the remainder of 2022.
